7th Sir Archibald Nedd Memorial Lecture a Success

St. George's, Monday, July 4, 2005:

The Grenada Bar Association held its seventh annual Sir Archibald Nedd Memorial Lecture sponsored by the Grenada Co-operative Bank Ltd., on Thursday, June 30, 2005 at the Grenada Trade Centre. This year featured Hon. Mia Mottley Q.C., Deputy Prime Minister and Attorney-General of Barbados, who delivered a scintillating lecture on the topic "*The Relevance of Insurance in Modern Caribbean Society: A critical look at the insurance industry post Hurricane Ivan*".

This was the first time the lecture was held at the Trade Centre, which readily accommodated the large numbers who attended. The lecture is one of the main mechanisms that the Bar Association uses to fulfill its mandate to inform, educate and sensitize the public on constitutional and other legal issues concerning their everyday lives.

In past years the topics focused more heavily on constitutional matters and had such distinguished speakers as Ms. Bernice Lake Q.C. (2004), Dr. Kenny Anthony, Prime Minister of St. Lucia (2003), and Dr. Ralph Gonsalves, Prime Minister of St. Vincent & the Grenadines (2002). However given the issues and experiences following the devastation of Hurricane Ivan last September it was felt that a focus on the insurance industry would be a most welcomed topic.
