



Co-op Bank Awards Fifteen Scholarships

On June 23, 2016, Grenada Co-operative Bank Limited awarded scholarships to fifteen students as part of its annual Super Starter Education Investment Plan Programme.

Seven silver scholarships, each valued at \$1,200, were awarded to primary school students and seven gold scholarships, each valued at \$2,500, were awarded to secondary school students. The lottery draw was conducted in the presence of the Bank's Auditors, Pannell Kerr Foster.

Co-op Bank's Super Starter Education Investment Plan Scholarship Programme was specially designed to ensure that Plan beneficiaries from all parishes, including Carriacou, qualify. For the past seven years, Grenada Co-operative Bank Limited has awarded 96 scholarships throughout the island, assisting parents to cover primary and secondary school expenses, and this year, the Bank presented fifteen more.
